Bartholomevian night is the mass kill of Huguenot in France, arranged by Catholics on the night of August 24, 1572, on the eve of St. Bartholomew.

According to a number of historians, only in one Paris then approximately 3,000 people died, whereas about 30,000 Huguenots were killed in the pogroms throughout France.

It is believed that the Bartholomeev night was provoked by Catherine Medici, who wanted to secure the world between the two opposing parties. However, Nor Pope, nor the Spanish King of Philip II, nor the most Ryasy Catholics of France did not share Catherine's policies.

The massacre occurred 6 days after the wedding of the Royal daughter Margarita with Protestant Heinrich Navarre. The murders began on August 23, after a couple of days after the attempt on the life of Admiral Gaspara Koliny - the military and political leader of Huguenots.
